The event will take place from May 22 to 24, 2024 at the Palais des Congrès in Dakhla. The aim of this event is to promote a constructive exchange between researchers and decision-makers, and to formulate recommendations on critical economic policy issues.

Paper submissions should be in the fields of macroeconomics and finance. Both empirical and theoretical papers will be considered. Preference will be given in this edition to papers on the theme of "Economic integration in Africa: the path to a more prosperous future", with clear policy recommendations. The choice of this theme aims to explore challenges and opportunities of economic integration in Africa. The aim is to stimulate debate on economic integration in Africa, and to formulate recommendations for further strengthening this integration, while promoting prosperity and sustainable, inclusive development on the continent. The main themes to be addressed include:

- 1. Opportunities and challenges of African economic integration;
- 2. Progress and challenges of the African Free Trade Area (AfCFTA);
- 3. International experiences of economic integration;
- 4. Technologies, Research and Innovation as levers for African integration;
- 5. Territorial development and African economic integration;
- 6. Contributions to regional and global value chains;
- 7. Development and sharing of regional infrastructures;

- 8. Climate change and economic integration;
- 9. Industrialization and the role of the private sector;
- 10. Financial integration and development of payment systems and means;
- 11. Regional food and energy security.

## Submission of proposals

The deadline for submission of the full papers is March 24, 2024. Authors of submitted papers will be informed of the decision of the scientific committee by April 5, 2024. Papers may be presented in French or English. Selected papers will be posted on the conference web portal.
