

Guidelines

- Abstracts should be no more than 150-200 words in English.
- Your abstract should be based on original academic research.
- Students are required to identify and consult with a faculty supervisor to ensure their work is of an acceptable academic standard.
- Your abstract should minimally have 4 components:
- 1. A thesis statement that highlights the main idea that your presentation will defend or explain.
- 2. A brief statement about method, i.e. how you conducted the research. For example, did you conduct surveys, analyze texts, review published articles, etc.
- 3. Supporting information derived from your original research that either supports or refutes your thesis.
- 4. A conclusion that summarizes what you found and how it connects back to your thesis.
