Guidelines

- *Abstracts should be no more than 150-200 words in English.*
- *Your abstract should be based on original academic research.*
- *Students are required to identify and consult with a faculty supervisor to ensure their work is of an acceptable academic standard.*
- *Your abstract should minimally have 4 components:*
 1. *A thesis statement that highlights the main idea that your presentation will defend or explain.*
 2. *A brief statement about method, i.e. how you conducted the research. For example, did you conduct surveys, analyze texts, review published articles, etc.*
 3. *Supporting information derived from your original research that either supports or refutes your thesis.*
 4. *A conclusion that summarizes what you found and how it connects back to your thesis.*
